Dear Parents,

We are aware that these are uncertain and unprecedented times and wish to reassure you that we are forward thinking and considering possible implications to our up-coming residential next week to Rock UK. This trip is planned to go ahead.

We will be maintaining the same high levels of hygiene when we are at the centre as we have been at school, with regular handwashing and hand-sanitizer available. The centre have had groups in this week and feel confident that they can minimize the spread of illness in much the same way they always have done.

Unfortunately, we do need to consider the eventualities that would result in the trip being cancelled or children having to be removed, I have outlined these below.

Event	Outcomes
<b>Before Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March</b>	
Government shuts schools	The trip will not go ahead and all monies will be refunded
Rock UK cancel the trip	The trip will not go ahead and all monies will be refunded
A child displays a continuous cough or high temperature	The child would not be permitted to go on the trip as they will need isolating for 7 days
<b>On or after Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March</b>	
A child displays a continuous cough or high temperature	The parents of the child will be informed and will need to arrange to have the child collected from Rock UK
A member of staff displays a continuous cough or high temperature	Mrs Brown will arrange for the staff member to be collected and will come to take over their duties
More than one member of staff displays a continuous cough or high temperature	The trip would need to be cut short as we do not have enough adults to cover this

Obviously it is our hope that this trip goes ahead as planned. We have had enquiries as to whether it could be postponed, but this is not an option as the centre is always fully booked a year in advance. We appreciate that this is frustrating but out of our control. We would ensure your children had a memorable and enjoyable experience and would organise something for them during the summer term.

As with all information surrounding the Coronavirus this is ever changing and we are constantly monitoring and adhering to Public Health England information and guidance. We thank you for your patience and reiterate that currently, the trip is going ahead so therefore ensure full payment is made.
