Dear Parents/Carers,

Reporting to Parents

You will receive the latest snapshot report on **Friday 18th March**. I am sure you are familiar now with the way in which we report your children's progress. Following summative (test) assessments and formative (observations and day to day work) assessments, we report to you on a termly basis to provide an insight into your child's current position on their learning journey across the year. These reports are published on the same form each term that will track children towards their end of year targets. Your child's end of year target is marked on the grid. This was a target set based on their starting points (either on entry to EYFS or KS1 assessment).

In order for your child to be making good progress they should be moving nearer to their end of year target, bearing in mind we are two thirds into the year. If you are concerned about the progress they are making, then you will be given the opportunity to talk to your child's teacher to find out the areas of learning you need to support them in.

As well as reporting on your child's academic progress, we also provide a snapshot of how they are performing in the two other areas of our curriculum; learning skills and values.

Teachers look at the end of year descriptors for learning skills to assess children. If your child is already able to use the skills as described on this document, then we identify this as a strength. If your child is working below their own year group skills, then this will be identified as a target. Please take a look at the skills ladders on our website to get an understanding of what these learning behaviours look like. Children are expected to uphold our values at all times, as these form our school rules. The majority of children in our school exhibit exemplary behavior and demonstrate these values in all they do. There are times though when children struggle to behave in ways that are loving, thoughtful, fair respectful, caring or grateful. If there is a particular value that your child fails to uphold on a regular basis and at an age appropriate level, then this will be identified on their report as a target.

Following the receipt of the snapshot report you are invited to book a parent/ teacher meeting. This conversation will be the same as the ten minute appointments you were used to in the past; providing an opportunity for your child's teacher to discuss academic strengths and gaps in their learning, what you can do to help them, the way in which they uphold the school values and utilise learning skills.

These meetings will take place via Zoom and will be held ***across the week of Monday 21st March.***

A few points to note:

A Zoom link will be sent out in an email at the start of that week – click the link to join the meeting. Join the meeting five minutes before your allocated time slot where you will be held in the waiting room.

Ensure ***the name displayed is your child's name*** (names the teacher does not recognise will not be let into the meeting).

If two parents wish to access the meeting but will not be using the same device, please let us know on your slip so that you can both be let into the meeting.

Meetings will be a prompt ten minutes long and will be ended by the teacher even if they are not finished.

Should you have a matter that needs discussing that you know will take longer than ten minutes, please arrange your meeting for another time.

Following the virtual meeting you will be invited to a Connect and Reflect afternoon where you can come in and celebrate your child's learning with them and get a flavour of the work they are doing in school. This will take place in the afternoon of Thursday 28th April.

We do hope you find this way of reporting to you useful and meaningful, and look forward to continuing working in partnership with you for the good of your children.
