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Dear Parents,

As the road map out of Covid-19 restrictions is now beginning to be actioned, it has prompted us to consider the implications of this for school. We have now spent over a year having to adapt and change the way we do things and we do not want to hurry back to old routines and events at the cost of putting the whole community at risk.

The current day to day organisation and safety measures will all remain in place for the rest of the term. We will continue to keep all measures under review and keep you updated with any changes we make.

The summer term is normally full of key dates and events. There are some of these that we have had to cancel completely but others that we are able to adapt so that they can still take place. We are aware that the roadmap hopes that all restrictions will end on 21st June, but in order to plan ahead and maintain the settled and purposeful atmosphere we have for children, we will not be changing our approach or published plans after this date.

The theme of respect week will be 'different on the outside'. The children will participate in a number of different activities to promote understanding, respect and tolerance whilst celebrating all our fabulous differences.

Sports Day

Year 5/6 Performance

Mrs Pearce has already started delivering a performing arts scheme of work to class 4, that will culminate in their end of year performance. Under the topic heading 'Meet the Artists' they are exploring L.S.Lowry and Frieda Kahlo and the musicians and performers from Manchester and Mexico. They will use these artists as inspiration to create dance, drama and art that they will share in their performance which will be made into a film.

Leavers' Service and Picnic – Friday 23rd July

We will hold a leavers' service for year 6 **ONLY** plus two adults each at 2.00 on our last day of term, Friday 23rd July. We hope that this can be hosted in church. This will be followed by a leavers' family picnic. Parents provide the seating, food and drinks and we will give you the space to do so.

Year 6 Secondary School Transition

If your child is going to Toot Hill in September, they will be invited for a day there on either **Monday 5th July or Tuesday 6th**. This will be followed by an online parents' information evening on **Wednesday 7th July**. We do not receive information from other secondary schools about transition events, as we are not a feeder school.

In School Transition

As a small school, ensuring children and teachers get to know each other a little before they form a new class in September is relatively easy as they cross paths on a regular basis. This year has been very different as bubbles have not mixed. Throughout the second half term we will plan opportunities for children to spend time with their new class teacher. However, they will not be able to mix with the other year group that they will be combined with as this would involve mixing bubbles.
