Thursday 7th March 2019 is World Book Day.

World Book Day is always a highlight on the Langar School calendar, especially as it has become somewhat of a tradition that we celebrate it with our friends from Gunthorpe School.

Our activities and events this year will be based on books by local author, Rachel Greaves, who will be visiting us for an assembly on the morning of World Book Day. She has written a delightful series of books based around the main character, Ruffles the Rail Dog. Following an exciting morning based at school, when children will have shared a favourite book they brought in and taken part in an inter-house book quiz, the children will come together with their peers from Gunthorpe to enjoy tasks and activities based around Ruffles books.

Our Key Stage 1 children (reception, years 1 and 2) will remain at Langar with KS1 children from Gunthorpe coming here to enjoy a school meal together, playtime and then an afternoon of fun activities, while Key Stage 2 children (years, 3, 4, 5 and 6) will be taken by coach to share lunch and playtime then activities with their Gunthorpe peers.

You will not need to make any adjustment to your child's usual lunch arrangements. Children who receive a school dinner – selected from a special World Book Day menu - will do so whether at Langar or Gunthorpe and packed lunches, for those who normally bring one, will still need to be provided by parents.

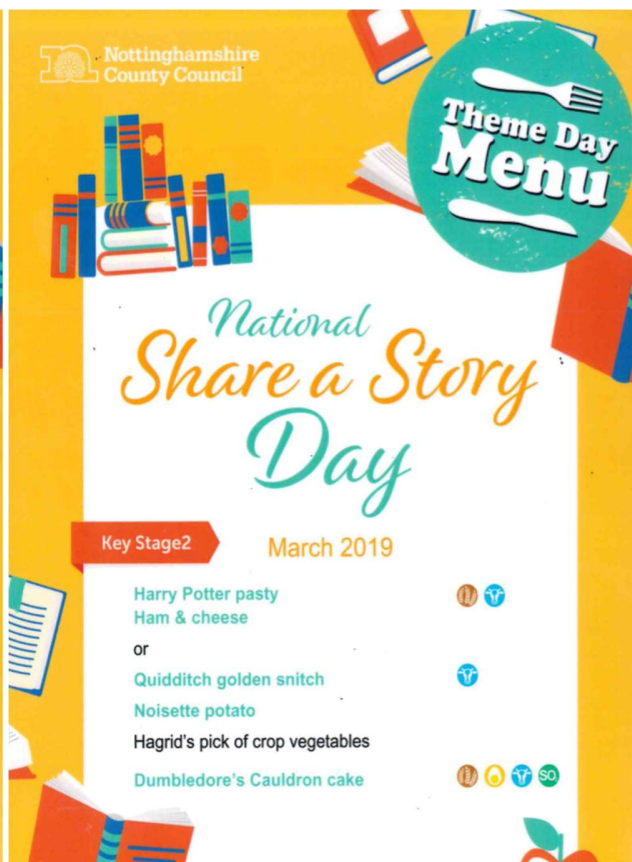
